INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR THE DESIGN OF THE GYEONGGI-DO JEONGOK MUSEUM Republic of Korea

The Gyeonggi Provincial Government in Korea, launches an international project competition, in a single stage, for the architectural design of a museum on the archaeological site of Jeongok-ri.

Considered to be one of the most important Palaeolithic sites in Korea, Jeongok-ri is of crucial importance for the interpretation of the geographic distribution and development of the Palaeolithic culture and human evolution.

In conformity with the UNESCO-UIA regulations, this competition has been approved by the International Union of Architects - UIA

OBJECTIVES AND PROGRAMME

The Museum, of a gross area of 5 000 m2, will be located near the site where the archaeological excavations are being pursued.

The project should make use of the proximity of the excavation site and highlight the striking qualities of the site and the archaeological objects to be exhibited.

The natural topography and geology of the site should also be integrated as also its exceptional location beside the Hantan river.

The Museum will be both an educational and entertainment place, devoted to local cultural and historic heritage.

A total amount of 170 000 US \$ will be awarded in prizes and distributed as follows:

1st Prize: US\$ 50,000; 2st Prize: 30,000 US\$; two 3st Prizes of 20,000 US\$ each; five mentions worth 10,000 US\$

The author of the project selected by the jury for the first prize will be commissioned for the construction of the Museum.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

Competitors shall present their projects on 6 panels, format A2 (594mm X 420 mm) on which will be displayed:

- . The site plan at scale 1/500°
- . Plans, elevations and sections at scale 1/200°
- . Schemas of exhibition concept, plans with circulation
- . Overall perspective
- Design description on 10 pages maximum (format A4 210mmX297 mm), in English.

A CD-Rom containing all submission materials, graphics in jpg (300 dpi or higher resolution), and design description for future publication.

All submissions must be made by post or hand delivery to the organisers by 20 March, 2006 at the latest
